

- The Current Philanthropy Sector is not Transparent
- Lack of Tools for Tracking Use of Proceed
- Charity Fraud Problem is increasing

Through the launch of HopeNFT with a physical seminar on SDG, it is believed that the cocreation of HopeNFT, empowering SDG/ ESG related projects with educational values on our Programmes in Business Service Management, focusing on service design and Higher Diploma in Transformative Business Management, targeting on identifying the key elements to transform with AI, NFT, Blockchain and concepts of design thinking for innovation.

This project aims to educate the community on using NFT as a Service for Fundraising to benefit SDG/ESG/ISP-related activities. It is to encourage the building up of a community of Art (Content Creation) Technology as well as Business. The NFT objects are Asian style paintings by youth and women from Kenya and Cameroon. Youth and women in these countries who participated in this project have learned how to paint in Chinese Calligraphy style and the subjects of these paintings are endangered species and plants such as elephants, lotus, and fish.
